Aunt Adeline's Bed and Breakfast is a 4 room inn. Originally a boarding house, it was built sometime between 1917 and 1923 and recently updated. It is an active property on the Federal Register of Historic Homes, located in Historic Hyman Heights. Downtown Hendersonville, the host of many activities and shows, is an easy 15 to 20 minute walk from the inn.

Our facility is temperature controlled with central air, central heat and an air filtration system.

For your comfort and convenience, we provide each room with an in-room bath w/shower, a queen or king size bed, a sitting area, a desk, WIFI connectivity, cable TV and DVD.

Our Hendersonville B&B home is located in a quiet residential district nestled in a grove of mature trees. The original oversized windows (with wavy glass) allow for ample lighting and impressive views of our park-like setting and the surrounding mountains.

One of the city's many walking and bike paths begins one-house-away from our front door. From there you can easily visit Patton Park to enjoy tennis, basketball, and swimming or watch all ages enjoying skateboarding and baseball/softball.
